RESEARCH TECHNICIAN

Grade: 4, 5 or 6 depending on experience and qualification

Duty Station: Grenoble, France

Job Description: The in-house research program of the EMBL Grenoble Outstation focuses on the structural molecular biology of complexes involved in eukaryotic cellular processes and molecular biology studies aimed at understanding regulation of gene expression (www.embl.fr).

The Outstation wants to recruit a research technician in the group of Ramesh Pillai. The group uses a combination of biochemical, cell and molecular biological approaches to study regulation of gene expression by non-coding RNAs (microRNAs). This position will involve active participation in on-going lab projects. However, the possibility of an independent project can also be explored.

Qualifications and experience:

Experience in mouse work is essential, as genotyping and maintenance of mouse strains will form part of the job. The successful candidate should have a background in basic molecular biology techniques. Experience with either mammalian or insect cell culture systems would be an asset.

Contract: An initial contract of 3 years duration will be offered to the successful candidate. This can be renewed, depending on circumstances at the time of review.
