Job Description: The Web Designer designs, produces and maintains various websites for the laboratory and contributes to the overall web communications strategy and special projects. The successful candidate will join the EMBL web team (2 people) and report to the Head of Communications.

Duties in this area will include:

- Designing web sites, including graphic and multimedia design
- Developing site maps, including navigation and layout of content
- Collecting information from clients and managing content
- Maintaining existing websites
- Lending web support to special projects

Qualifications and Experience: The ideal candidate should have at least one year professional experience as a web designer. Strong experience in a combination of codes, such as hypertext mark-up language (HTML), skills in cascading style sheets (CSS) and using development environments, such as Macromedia Dreamweaver is required. A solid background in graphic design packages such as Fireworks or Photoshop is also necessary.

The Web Designer should have a good command of English and preferably some experience in a multidisciplinary international environment. A service-oriented attitude, excellent communication and interpersonal skills and the ability to work professionally under pressure are essential. The post holder should be able to work independently as well as enjoys working in a team.
