Job Description: The current project in Macromolecular Crystallography is part of the SPINE2-COMPLEXES (<http://www.spine2.eu/index.php>) and aims to implement the most successful and generic technique on a beamline. The selected candidate will work within the Instrumentation Group, Diffraction Instrumentation Team and will benefit from the close collaborations between the EMBL and the European Synchrotron Radiation Facility in Grenoble.

Qualifications and Experience: We are looking for a highly motivated postdoctoral fellow who will be involved in the development and the evaluation of techniques for improving the diffraction quality of macromolecular crystals. In addition to a good knowledge of macromolecular crystallography, the successful candidate shows an interest for instrumentation.

Furthermore the incumbent is a team player, with a sense of initiative and responsibility, and is fluent in English.
